What is Sentio and how does it work?

Sentio is a decentralised data and compute network designed to provide blockchain data infrastructure for developers building decentralised applications. The network offers modular tooling including data indexing, analytics, smart contract debugging, simulation, and alerting capabilities across multiple blockchain ecosystems. Developers interact with the network through an SDK that supports multiple programming languages and formats. Data access is facilitated through Sentio Nodes, which operate as distributed compute and indexing providers across the network.

At the time of writing, the token is not live. The ST token will be used for payments to access blockchain data, with users consuming Sentio Units (SU) settled in ST. Node operators stake ST to qualify for network participation, and token holders may delegate their stake to node operators in exchange for a share of rewards. ST also carries governance rights, enabling holders to vote on protocol decisions.

Who is behind the project?

Sentio was co-founded by Fuyao Zhao (CEO), Chongzhe Li, and Kan Qiao.

Tokenomics of ST

The total supply of ST is 1 billion tokens which is distributed as follows:

Risks specific to ST

Competition

The Sentio network faces competition from other decentralised data and compute infrastructure protocols such as The Graph, Chainlink, and others. Sentio's value derives from its broader adoption in the market. If the Sentio network fails to achieve sufficient adoption compared to the other options in the market, this could negatively impact the value of ST.

Due Diligence

Prior to listing on the Kraken platform, Kraken performed due diligence on ST and determined that ST is unlikely to be a security or derivative under UK securities legislation. Our analysis generally includes, but is not limited to, reviewing publicly available information on the following:

- The creation, governance, usage and design of ST, including the source code, security and roadmap for growth in the developer community and, if available, the background of the developer(s) that created ST;
- The supply, demand, maturity, utility and liquidity of ST;
- Material technical risks associated with ST, including any code defects, security breaches and other threats concerning ST and its supporting blockchain (such as the susceptibility to hacking and impact of forking), or the practices and protocols that apply to them; and
- Legal and regulatory risks associated with ST, including (i) any pending, potential, or prior civil, regulatory, criminal, or enforcement action relating to the issuance, distribution, or use of ST, and (ii) consideration of statements made by any regulators or securities regulatory authorities in the UK, other regulators of the International Organization of Securities Commissions, or the regulator with the most significant connection to ST about whether ST, or generally about whether the type of crypto asset, is a security and/or derivative.
