What is Hamster Kombat and how does it work?

Hamster Kombat is a blockchain-based game where players collect, train, and battle unique digital hamsters using non-fungible tokens (NFTs). The game incorporates a play-to-earn (P2E) model, allowing users to earn rewards by participating in gameplay and ecosystem activities. Built on blockchain technology, the game aims to provide transparency, asset ownership, and decentralized engagement.

Players use the HMSTR token for in-game purchases, battles, and governance activities. NFTs represent the hamster characters, each of which can be leveled up and used in strategic combat scenarios. The game uses smart contracts to secure ownership and ensure the fairness of battles. Hamster Kombat positions itself within the GameFi space, combining gaming with decentralized finance elements to engage its community in both entertainment and earning opportunities.

Who is behind the Project?

The project is spearheaded by Eduard Gurinovich. The development team is focused on creating a fun, decentralised play-to-earn experience, leveraging blockchain technology to ensure transparency and security in the game.

Tokenomics of Hamster Kombat:

The total token supply of Hamster Kombat is 100,000,000,000 HMSTR. Token distribution was designed to support partnerships, liquidity, team incentives, and early community participation.

Risks specific to Hamster Kombat

Competition Risk

The Hamster Kombat Game network faces competition from other blockchain-based games and GameFi projects such as Axie Infinity, Decentraland, and The Sandbox. Hamster Kombat Game's value derives from its broader adoption in the market. If the Hamster Kombat Game network fails to achieve sufficient adoption compared to other gaming options, this could negatively impact the value of HMSTR.

Due Diligence

Prior to listing on the Kraken platform, Kraken performed due diligence on Hamster Kombat. Kraken was permitted to make Hamster Kombat available for trading to UK users, in compliance with UK law. This process generally consists of reviewing publicly available information on the following:

- The creation, governance, usage and design of Hamster Kombat, including the source code, security and roadmap for growth in the developer community and, if available, the background of the developer(s) that created Hamster Kombat;
- The supply, demand, maturity, utility and liquidity of Hamster Kombat;
- Material technical risks associated with Hamster Kombat, including any code defects, security breaches and other threats concerning Hamster Kombat and its supporting blockchain (such as the susceptibility to hacking and impact of forking), or the practices and protocols that apply to them; and
- Legal and regulatory risks associated with Hamster Kombat, including (i) any pending, potential, or prior civil, regulatory, criminal, or enforcement action relating to the issuance, distribution, or use of Hamster Kombat, and (ii) consideration of statements made by any regulators or securities regulatory authorities in the UK, other regulators of the International Organization of Securities Commissions, or the regulator with the most significant connection to Hamster

Kombat about whether Hamster Kombat, or generally about whether the type of crypto asset, is a security and/or derivative.
